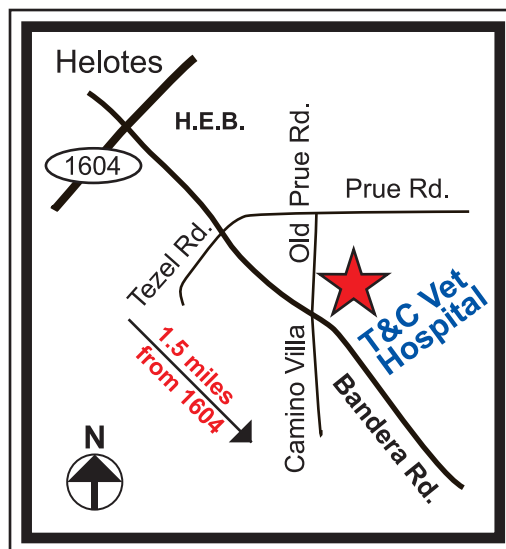
With our grooming facilities located within the veterinary hospital, *the SPAw* offers added safety and security for your pets, whether they are:

## Driving Directions

*The SPAw* is located within **Town & Country Veterinary Hospital**, in the **Town & Country Shopping Center** at the southeast corner of Bandera Road (Tx-16) and Old Prue Road. We can be reached from either Loop 1604 or I-410 by turning onto Bandera Road.



All pets to be groomed at TCVH must be at least 8 weeks old, tested negative for intestinal parasites in the last 12 mos., and be current on vaccinations, according to **TCVH protocol**. Puppies less than 12 weeks of age must have their first round of boosters at least 2 weeks before grooming.

*If your pet has **not** been kept current on their Rabies vaccinations, we require a **2 week waiting period** after inoculation in order to allow for their antibodies to develop, to ensure their safety.*

Pets must also be free from parasite infestation and have an amiable disposition (non-aggressive and socialized).
